I. MEMBERS PRESENT:

II. PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS:

1. The president informed old the mambers that 'Jalavayo Vihar Apartment owners 'Association' has been registered and the same has been informed to Air Force Naval Housing Board. NEW DELHI.

- 2. The president informed members that Manjire Water connection is likely to be completed by January, 15th.
- 3. On behalf of association a letter was written to all major industrial establishments intimating them the availability of houses with all facilities, for Rent purpose in Jalavayu Vihor.

III. AGENDA POINTS:

Maintenance Charges from the members and the expendituree involved have been discussed and the following decisions have been taken in this regard.

3. Since the income is hardly sufficient to maintain the above expenditure, the members have decided the following:

a) Association should approach the Board to release the funds Collected as Society charges.

b) To get the initial capital, members may pay a lump sum maintena-nce charges of Rs. 1000/- (for type V & VI) and Rs. 800/- for Type II & III per year.

c) To discourage commercial activities weep the colony as a worth residential area members have decided to levy additional maintenance charges on those houses which are not used strictly for residential purposes. The charges would be Rs.500/- PM for Type V & VI and Rs. 400/- PM for Type II & III.

4. It has been decided that payments including orrears of maintenance charges should be Paid latest by 31st January, 1993. Delayed payment will attract a penality of Rs. 10/- per month. In case of default for more than three months, Water supply will be connec-

5. SECURITY ARRANGEMENTS:

Since the roads thro' the colony cannot be closed, it was decided by the members to take the following steps to tighten the security.

a) All vendors are to have "Permit Pass" from the Association.

b) All the memb r's Vehicles are to have "Association Strckers" to enable the Security Staff to identify their movement.

c) Disposel of Garbage: It was decided that no Garbage Bins are to be kept at the road sides. Instead, the residents are to keep the Garbage in a closed Container/Plastic covers, So that Sweepers can collect and dispose off in the pits made for the purpose.

6. The Clerk of the Association shall be available for helping the tenants to pay the Electricity charges/Telephone Bills on paym ent of Rs. 5/- extra for each bill. The money is to be paid to the Clerk at the Office.

Terms of Reference have been finalised and issued to the Committee. It is expected that Star T.V. with 5 channels will be in operation by the end of January, 1993. The Ster TV contractor is required to pay 10% of the Collection as layy to the Association.

- 8. Telephone Booth: It has been decided that a Telephone Booth will be permitted to be set up by a handicapped person in the Campus. The name of Mr. Srinivas a resident of H.No. 174, has been recommended accordingly by the members.
- 9. HIS SERVICES: APSRIG is agreeable to operate the City Buses as per our requirement. As soon as adequate commuters are available the bus services can be planned.
- 10. Shri App Rao, IFS (Retd.) has been unamimously elected as the Member-in-charge for harticulture in the Campus.
- 11. The members have asked the committee to take the following actions.

a) To approach APDDC for starting a Milk Booth.

b) To approach the Post - Master General to keep the Mail Boxes and effect delivery of letters to individual houses in the Campus.

c) The bylaws should be printed and made available to the members on Sale of a cost of Rs.20/-

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
