- 2. <u>Renovation of Akash Ganga: -</u>The herculinious job of Akash Ganga renovation work completed within three month with help of committee formed in the AGM Dt: 31<sup>st</sup> July 2022 as well as the secretary who took the initiative more effectively to complete the work.
